Public Information Session Survey Results

Introduction

Two Public Information Sessions were held on November 7 and November, 13 2019 during which the progress of the Henrico County Public Schools (HCPS) redistricting project was shared with the public. The latest DRAFT Options developed by the committee, Options A and B, were displayed on large maps along with tables indicating how each met the guiding principles issued by HCPS. Approximately 1,200 community members attended the Public Information Sessions. The public was encouraged to provide their feedback regarding each boundary option for the committee’s consideration. These questionnaires were accepted via an online survey until November 24, 2019.

The data that is presented as a result of this Public Information Session should be used as a tool to help facilitate the redistricting project. **It should not be used ALONE as a decision-making tool for the Redistricting Project.** The committee will utilize data from the information session (in this report), and will focus on the project guidelines as the primary criteria for developing the project’s plan.

Analysis Methodology

Received online surveys were exported to an excel spreadsheet. The spreadsheet tracked the date the comment was received, the elementary school zone the respondent is associated with, and the respondent’s comments on each option.

In order to gain a better understanding of the responses, respondents were asked to provide the general attitude towards a comment based on the following categories: *Approve, Like, Neutral, Dislike* and *Oppose*. Respondents were also asked to provide a reason for concern if they did not support an option, in order to gain a better understanding of the nature of the objection. The prominent concern themes were Enrollment, Neighborhood, Transportation, Feeder Pattern, Demographics, or N/A.

In order to gain a better understanding of where the majority of the respondents are coming from throughout the district, the respondents were asked *“In which elementary school zone do you live?”*.

The table on the right reflects that there were 3,673 total respondents to the survey, and the largest share of feedback was provided by community members who live in the Short Pump, Pemberton, Longan, and Crestview Elementary school zones.

Option Attitude Summary Tables for All Submitted Comments

The following provides a general summary on the respondent’s overall attitude related to DRAFT Options A and B. Important points to consider as you read this set of tables:

1. The majority of responses that were submitted were in regard to the most suitable Option for the respondent’s particular neighborhood / subdivision.
2. As is evident in the ‘Total Respondents by Live-In Elementary School Zone’ table on the previous page, the geographic distribution of respondents is uneven, so these summary tables should not be used as the ONLY defining factor or indicator over which Options are best suited for the entire district.
3. The committee needs to maintain focus on building a solution that best meets the Redistricting guidelines.

Elementary Options Attitude Summary

When asked ‘What is your overall attitude toward an ES option?’ the largest percentage of respondents said they approve of ES Option A. ES Option B had a lower percentage of respondent support (35% approve as compared to 60.3% for Option A) and a higher percentage of respondent opposition (32.8% as compared to 14.7% for Option A).

The table below shows what the primary concerns were for those that opposed a plan. Of the stated concerns, neighborhood concern represented the largest share for Option A (11.9%) and for Option B (15.9%).

Middle School Options Attitude Summary

When asked ‘What is your overall attitude toward a MS option?’ the largest percentage of respondents said they approved of MS Option A (39.2%), but a large share of respondents also stated their opposition to MS Option A (34.7%). MS Option B had a larger percentage of opposition than MS Option A and had less approval, with 37.4% of respondents opposing MS Option B and 29.0% of respondents approving of MS Option B.

The table below show what the primary concerns were for those who opposed an option. For MS Option A, stated concerns were closely split among neighborhood concerns, transportation concerns, and feeder pattern concerns. Results were similar for MS Option B.

High School Options Attitude Summary

When asked 'What is your overall attitude toward a HS option?' the largest percentage of respondents said they opposed HS Option B (68.6%), but a large share of respondents also stated their opposition to HS Option A (50.6%). HS Option B had little approval from respondents, receiving only 14.6% approval from respondents. HS Option A had higher approval, at 34.9%.
