2025 HIGH SCHOOL REDISTRICTING

PROJECT SUMMARY

Dublin City Schools is working with Cropper GIS Consulting, specialists in K-12 redistricting and facility planning, to balance enrollment across all three high schools. This project aims to address three key challenges:

- ✓ Rapid enrollment growth in the northwest quadrant of the district
- ✓ Uneven distribution of students in grades 9-12
- ✓ Limited fiscal capacity to fund large-scale new construction

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



WHEN WILL THE FINAL BOUNDARIES BE ANNOUNCED?

The final boundaries will be published on November 10, 2025.

WHEN WILL NEW BOUNDARIES BECOME EFFECTIVE?

New boundaries will be effective at the start of the 2026–2027 school year.

WILL ANY STUDENTS BE PERMITTED TO REMAIN AT THEIR CURRENT SCHOOL?

Beginning with the 2026–2027 school year, students will be assigned to the high school that serves their residential address under the new boundaries.

- **Default Assignment:** Students will automatically be enrolled at the high school assigned to their residence.
- **Option to Remain (if impacted):** Impacted students who will be sophomores, juniors, or seniors in 2026–2027 (Classes of 2029, 2028, and 2027) may choose to remain at their current high school. If a student elects to remain, the family will be responsible for transportation to and from school. ***This option does not extend to siblings.***
- **No Option to Remain:** Students who will be in 8th grade (Class of 2030) or younger will attend the high school assigned to their residence under the new boundaries.

CAN I SEND MY CHILD TO A SCHOOL OTHER THAN THE ONE THEY ARE ASSIGNED?

No. All students will attend the school assigned to their residence in the redistricting plan. Intradistrict transfer applications are only allowed for schools with capacity, and due to current and projected enrollment, all schools will be at or above capacity.

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
