# 2024 ELEMENTARY/MIDDLE SCHOOL REDISTRICTING

## **PROJECT SUMMARY**

Dublin City Schools is working with Cropper GIS Consulting, specialists in K-12 redistricting and facility planning, to prepare for the opening of Bishop Elementary School in fall 2025. This project aims to:

- Establish an attendance zone for Bishop Elementary.
- ✓ Balance student populations and relieve overcrowding.
- ✓ Align boundaries with long-term facilities planning and feeder patterns.

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### WHICH SCHOOLS WILL BE IMPACTED BY REDISTRICTING?

Elementaries: Abraham Depp, Deer Run, Glacier Ridge, Pinney

Middle Schools: Eversole Run, Grizzell, Karrer, Sells



#### WHEN WILL NEW BOUNDARIES BECOME EFFECTIVE?

New boundaries will be effective at the start of the 2025-2026 school year.

#### WILL ANY STUDENTS BE PERMITTED TO REMAIN AT THEIR CURRENT SCHOOL?

No. All students and their siblings will attend school in the attendance area outlined in the redistricting plan. This includes rising fifth and eighth graders and students with disabilities.

#### CAN I SEND MY CHILD TO A SCHOOL OTHER THAN THE ONE THEY ARE ASSIGNED?

No. All students will attend school in the attendance area outlined in the redistricting plan. Intradistrict transfer policy only allows for transfer applications for schools with capacity, and due to current and projected enrollment numbers, all schools will be at or above capacity.

#### WHAT ABOUT HIGH SCHOOL REDISTRICTING?

At this time, the district is focused on the ongoing elementary and middle school redistricting process. No work will be done on high school redistricting until after the New Year, and answers about how boundaries will shift will not be available until the summer of 2025.
