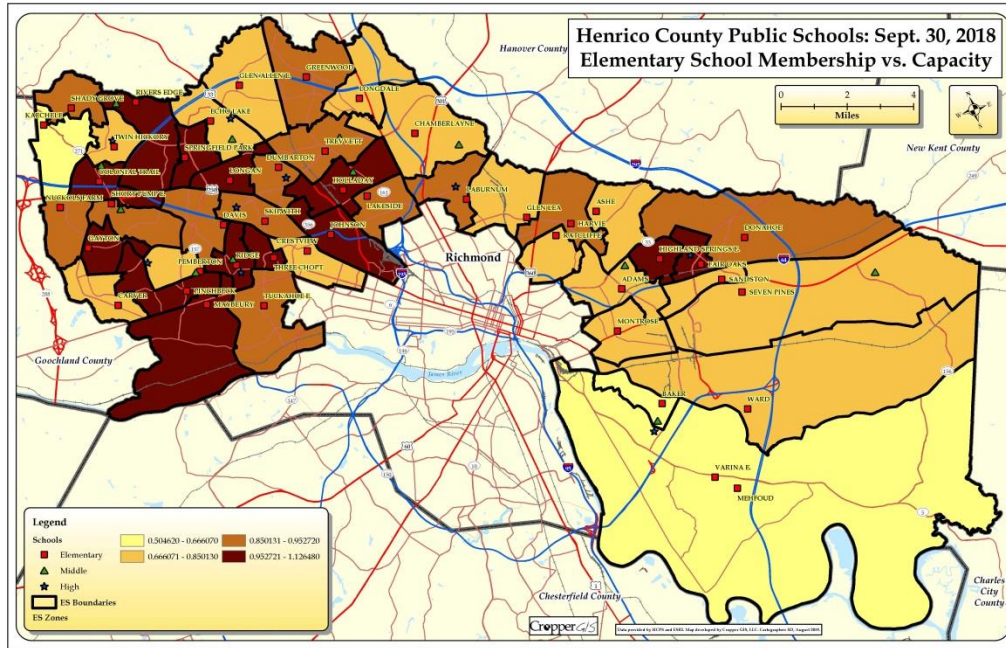


Henrico County Public Schools, VA Redistricting Project for 2021:

Options Enrollment Trends and Subdivision Developments

Project Goals

1. *Efficiently using all available space and planning for future county growth.*
2. *Determining attendance boundaries for the expanded Holladay Elementary School (7300 Galaxie Road), which will double in size when an addition opens for the 2021-22 school year.*
3. *Accounting for the increased building capacity available when replacements for Highland Springs (15 S. Oak Ave.) and J. R. Tucker (2910 Parham Rd.) high schools open on their current sites for the 2021-22 school year.*
4. *Reducing concentrations of poverty while balancing a community or neighborhood school concept.*

Enrollment Trends Assumptions

The following document contains a series of tables that depict the trends for current school enrollment and statistics for expected student yields from developments, as well as redistricting options that are being evaluated internally and publicly.

If there are more students in lower grade levels than the higher grade levels this shows enrollment growth since the lower, larger grade levels will move up through the school, while the higher, smaller grade levels will move on to the next school. Enrollment growth is symbolized by a green arrow pointing up. If there are fewer students in lower grade levels than the higher grade levels this shows enrollment decline since the lower, smaller grade levels will move up through the school, while the higher, larger grade levels will move on to the next school. A negative trend is symbolized by a red arrow pointing down. If the all of the grade levels are approximately the same size, then there is enrollment stability, this is symbolized by a yellow line. See the reference below for each of the symbols. All Student counts are based off of the 09/30/2018 HCPS Student Database.

The trend data helps to understand how enrollment will change with the absence of in-migration (i.e. future residential construction). In addition to the trend data, we have provided the number of students expected from future residential development. This will help understand the number of students that can be expected from future approved residential development (per the County Planning Office as of Aug. 1, 2019). It is important to not only look at future students from new housing, but also understand if a school area is expected to have enrollment growth, stability, or decline.
