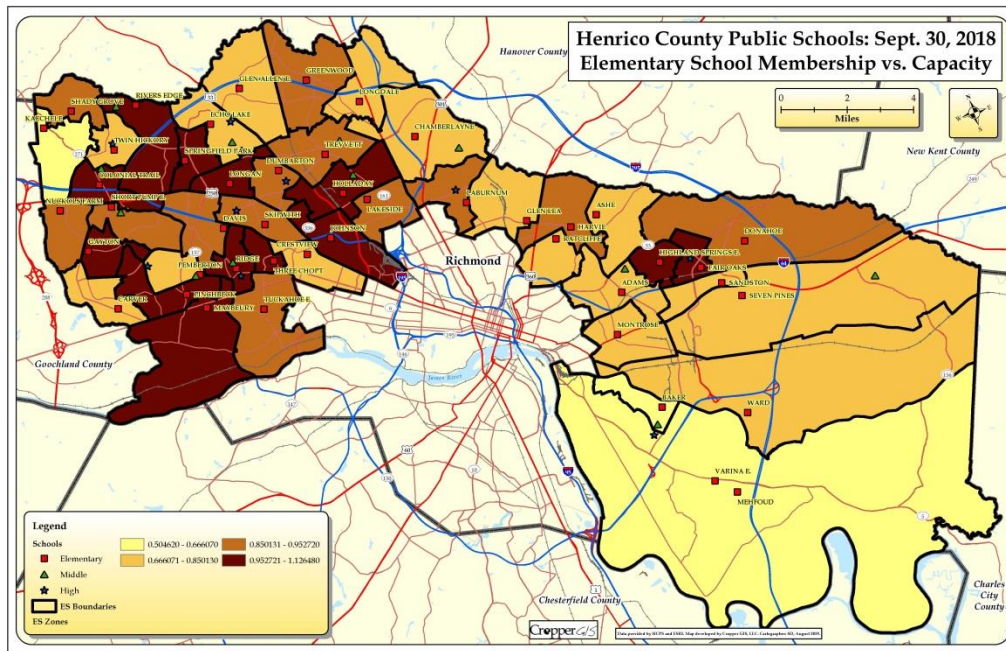


Henrico County Public Schools, VA Redistricting Project for 2021:

Public Information Session Options Statistics

Revised: 11/01/2019



Project Goals

1. Efficiently using all available space and planning for future county growth.
2. Determining attendance boundaries for the expanded Holladay Elementary School (7300 Galaxie Road), which will double in size when an addition opens for the 2021-22 school year.
3. Accounting for the increased building capacity available when replacements for Highland Springs (15 S. Oak Ave.) and J. R. Tucker (2910 Parham Rd.) high schools open on their current sites for the 2021-22 school year.
4. Reducing concentrations of poverty while balancing a community or neighborhood school concept.



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Enrollment Statistics Assumptions

The following document contains a series of tables and maps that depict statistics for current schools and boundaries, as well as redistricting options that are being evaluated internally and publicly. This information will help inform all stakeholders on how schools could be potentially impacted as a result of potential redistricting adjustments, along with a comparison to current school information.

When estimating enrollment for the redistricting options, a series of assumptions were made. These assumptions help to ensure that actual enrollments will materialize as close to the estimates as possible. The following assumptions were made:

1. The only students that are moved in the estimates are those that live and attend their zoned school.
2. Any student attending a school other than their zoned school will continue to attend that school.
3. The capacity of Holladay ES will increase from 506 to 1,100 students.
4. The capacity of Highland Springs HS will increase from 1,788 to 2,006 students.
5. The capacity of Tucker HS will increase from 1,958 to 1990 students.

All Student counts are based off of the 09/30/2018 HCPS Student Database.

Glossary of Terms

Capacity -the number of students that an individual school has the physical capacity to enroll and can be reasonably accommodated in a facility.

Utilization - Utilization is the enrollment divided by the capacity, described as a percentage.

Live-in students – Students residing inside of a school attendance boundary, regardless of where that student attends school.

Live and Attend-in students – Students that live inside a school attendance boundary, and attends that school.

Live-out Attend-in students – Students that live outside of the 2018-19 attendance boundaries for the school that they attend, but attend that school.

Out of District students – Students that live outside of the Henrico County Public Schools boundary.

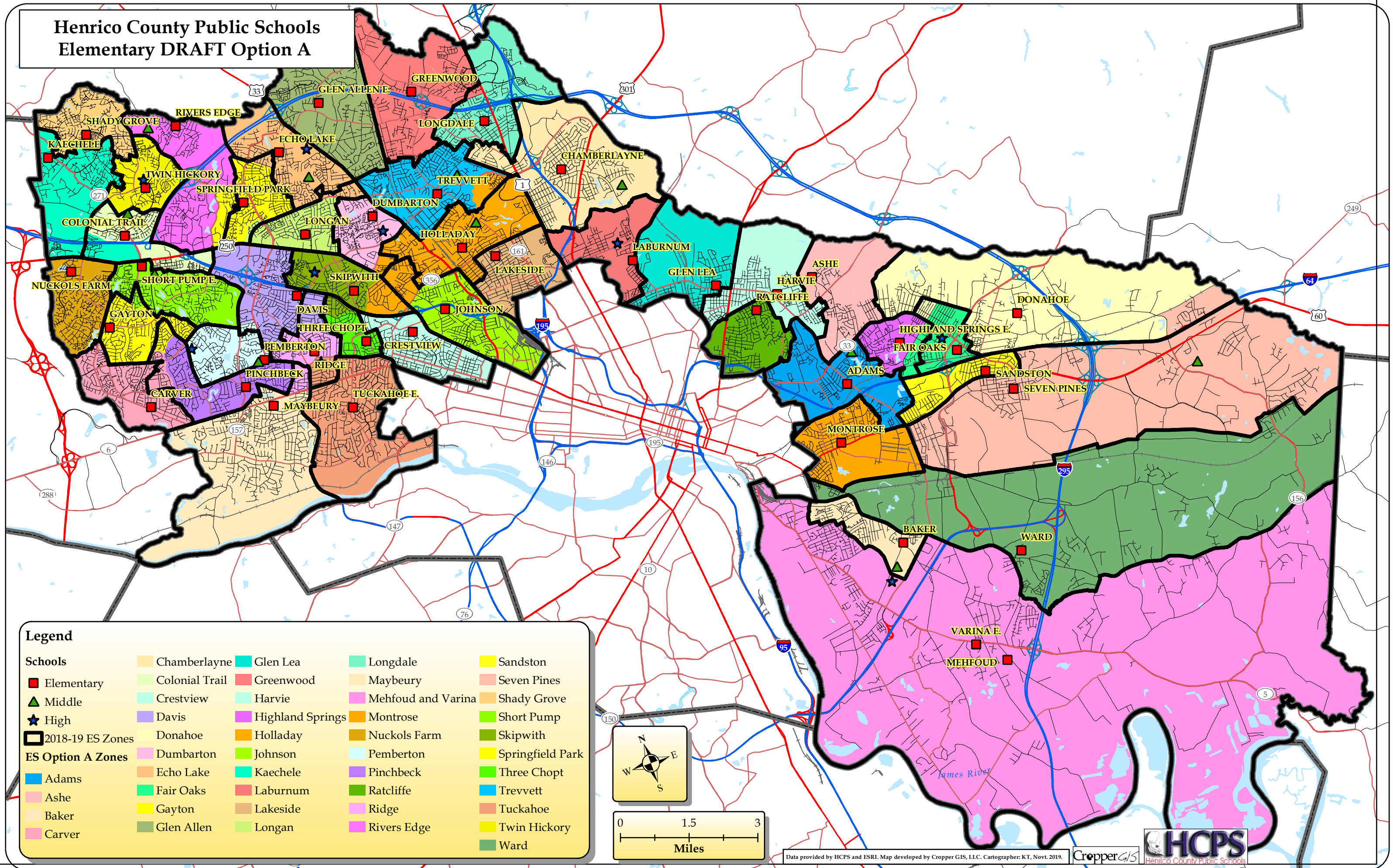
Unmatched students – Students whose address was not able to be located by the GIS.

Estimated Enrollment – Estimated Enrollment is calculated by adding the Live and Attend-in students plus the Live-Out Attend-In, Out of District, and Unmatched students.

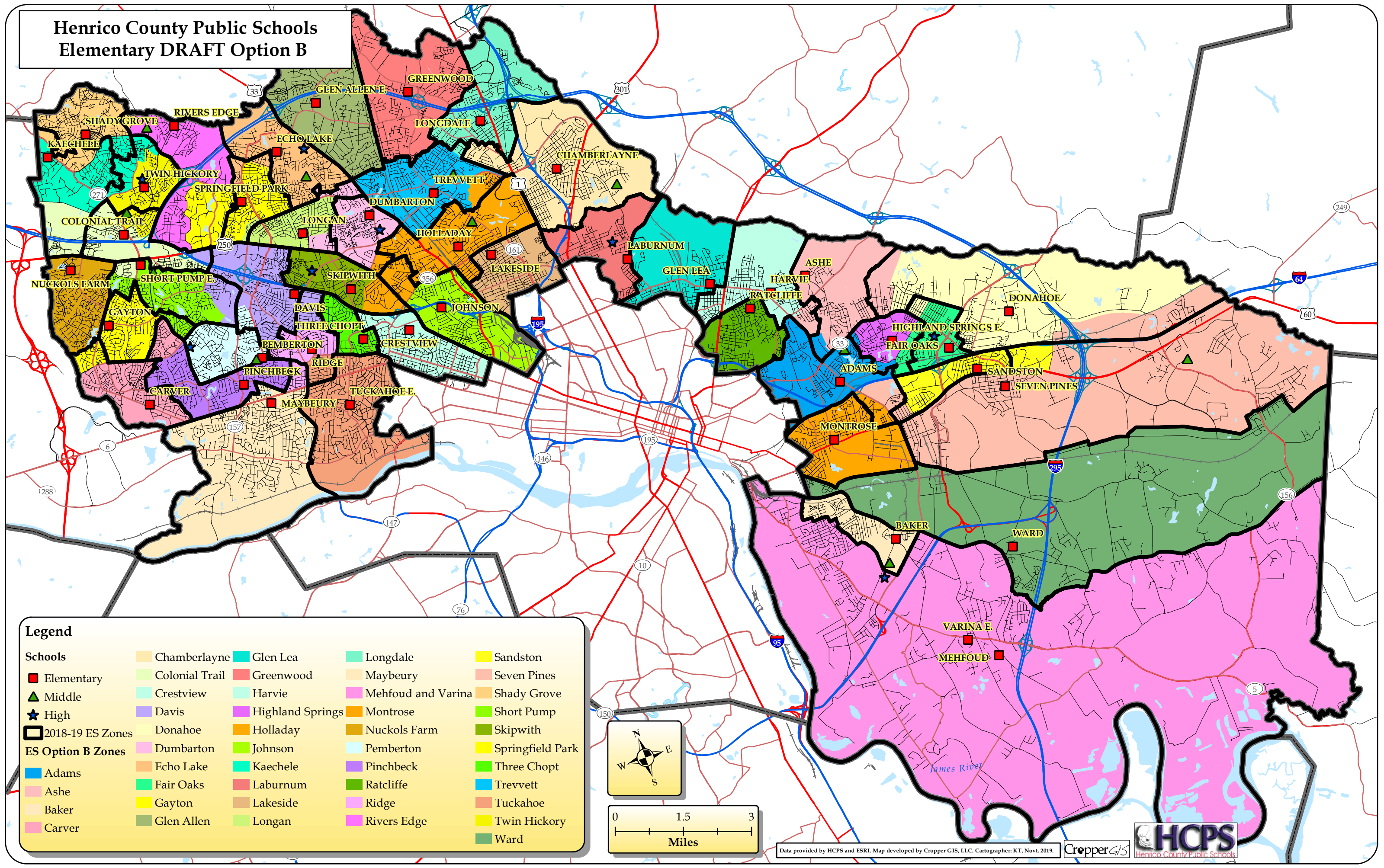
Option Impact – The number of Live and Attend-In students that change attendance boundaries from the 2018-19 attendance boundaries given each option. In other words, an estimate of the total number of students that could be impacted per any of the options.

Feeder Pattern – The number of students living within the attendance boundary of both a lower grade cohort (ex. Elementary schools) and a higher grade cohort (i.e. Middle School). This is given as both the number of Live-in students, and described as a percentage.
