


# DRAFT Boundary Options Green & Orange and Statistics







#### 2024-25 Capacity, Official Enrollment, and Building Utilizations

The following document contains a series of tables that depict statistics for current schools and boundaries that are being evaluated. This information will help inform all stakeholders on how schools could be potentially impacted as a result of potential enrollment adjustments. The current student enrollment numbers were derived from the district's 2024-25 Student Database dated January 2025. For estimated enrollment purposes, it is assumed that PS/PK enrollment will remain at New Trails Learning Center and Three Trails Preschool.

#### **Glossary of Terms**

Capacity - the number of students that an individual school has the physical capacity to enroll and can be reasonably accommodated in a facility.

Utilization - Utilization is the total enrollment divided by the capacity, described as a percentage.

Utilization Color Key
Within \*/-10% of Study Area Average
Between \*/-10-15% from Study Area Average
Greater than \*/-15% from Study Area Average

<u>Live In students</u> - Students residing inside of a school attendance boundary, regardless of where that student attends school.

Out of District students - Students that live outside of the Raytown C-2 School District's boundary.

<u>Unmatched students</u> - Students whose address could not be located in our GIS software.

<u>Feeder Pattern</u> – The number of students living within the attendance boundary of both a lower grade cohort (ex. Elementary schools) and a higher-grade cohort (i.e., Middle School). This is given as a percentage of Live-In students.

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#### **DRAFT Options Green & Orange**

The following tables present DRAFT options for the Internal Planning Team's (IPT) review. Option Green will be converting all Elementary schools across the district to a K-6<sup>th</sup> grade enrollment with the two Middle Schools serving 7-8<sup>th</sup> grade students. Central middle school will be repurposed and no longer operate as a middle school for the district. Option Green takes a proactive approach to the forecasted enrollment decline by consolidating certain grades and facilities to maximize building use. Option Orange will keep all grade configurations as they currently are with elementary schools serving K-5<sup>th</sup> graders, middle schools serving 6-8<sup>th</sup> grade students, as well as keeping all middle schools open as they currently are. Option Orange will also create additional space in Central Middle in order to move the RSA program into that facility. Keep in mind that these options are only starting points for discussion. Any of the following options can be changed based on feedback from the IPT, public, and district administration.

#### **DRAFT Options Green & Orange Enrollment Estimates**

The following tables reflect the DRAFT options enrollment estimates. The estimated enrollment is calculated by adding the total students served that "Live In" a school zone within each new DRAFT Option, plus the total students that were "Out of District" or "Unmatched" for the 2024-25 school year.
