

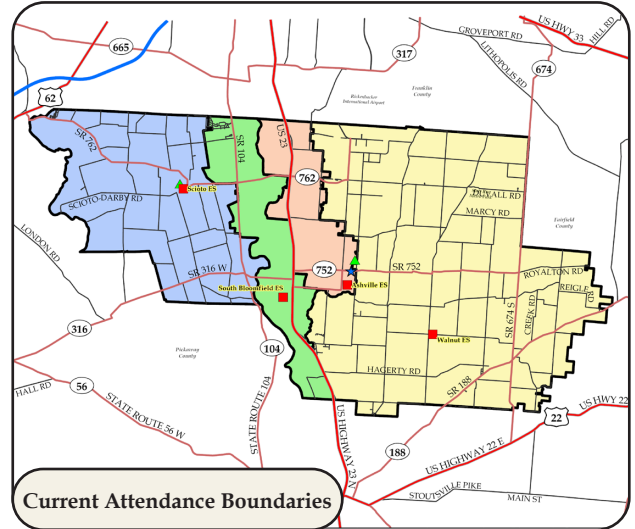
# Teays Valley Local School District, OH 2024-25 Redistricting Study Fast Facts



## Background

Teays Valley Local School District is undertaking a redistricting study to address imbalances in school utilization and enrollment, and to pro-actively account for future growth within the district. Teays Valley Local School District has begun a redistricting study to meet the following key objectives:

- **Primary Objective:** Evaluate elementary and middle school attendance boundaries to ensure that building utilization is balanced while accounting for new residential growth within the district.
- **Secondary Objectives:** Ensure the district is maintaining equity in each building regarding ethnic and socioeconomic demographics.



## Key Points about DRAFT Redistricting Options

- Scioto Elementary will be closer to full capacity due to the intentional reassignment of more students to that building. Key reasons include:
  - Lower predicted growth in the Scioto boundary area, allowing more stability.
  - Available space at Scioto for modular classrooms, if needed.
- Limitations on Modular Classrooms at Other Schools:
  - Ashville Elementary: Modular classrooms cannot be added due to being land-locked.
  - South Bloomfield Elementary: Adding modular classrooms would require plumbing installations.
  - Walnut Elementary: Space for modular classrooms is limited, and placement on opposite sides of the building would result in grade levels being separated.
- Balancing Capacity Across Schools
  - To distribute capacity percentages more evenly, Southern Point was reassigned to Scioto Elementary, which necessitated reassigning some current Scioto students to South Bloomfield Elementary.
  - The goal was to keep neighborhoods together wherever possible.
  - TV West MS is nearing capacity, so the new boundary lines will better balance the two middle schools.
- Planning for Future Growth
  - The district accounted for anticipated growth in high-development areas.
  - For example, a new neighborhood, projected to match the size of Southern Point, is planned within the Ashville boundary.
- Equity Across Schools
  - The redistricting plan tries to ensure each school maintains balanced representation in ethnic and socioeconomic demographics, supporting equity district-wide.

## Criteria

The following criteria are not listed in any order of importance and the recommended plan will be one that best adheres to these criteria as a whole as best as possible:

- Balance school facility utilization
- Account for future growth
- Close Proximity
- Maximize busing efficiencies in transportation of students
- Minimize impact on students
- Consider economic, cultural, and ethnic diversity
- Make every effort to establish contiguous zones
- Use major roads and natural boundaries wherever feasible to define attendance zones
