



Glossary of Terms

Capacity - the number of students that an individual school has the physical capacity to enroll and can be reasonably accommodated in a facility.

Utilization - Utilization is the enrollment divided by the capacity, described as a percentage.

Live-in students - Students residing inside of a school attendance boundary, regardless of where that student attends school.

Unmatched - Students whose home address was not able to be placed on the map.

Out of District students - Students that live outside of the McLean County Unit District No. 5 boundary.

Feeder Pattern - The number of students living within the attendance boundary of both a lower grade cohort (ex. Elementary schools) and a higher-grade cohort (i.e., Junior High School). This is given as both the number of live-in students, and described as a percentage
